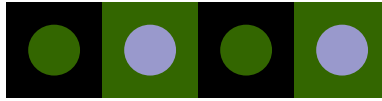
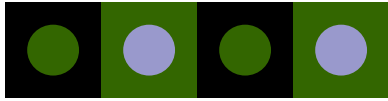
Herbs

<i>Basil, Lime</i>	Seed from Territorial Seed Company. Annual. The other citrus basil! Similar intensity as lemon basil. Try in salads and even ice tea!
<i>Basil, Greek/Globe</i>	Seed from Seed Saver Exchange. Annual. Well-behaved 12" plants. More mild basil, great for breads.
<i>Basil, Napoletano</i>	Seed from Johnny's Selected Seed. Annual. Napoletano is one of the more intense basil varieties; great in pesto. (To keep pesto bright green, blanch basil first. Pesto also freezes well.)
<i>Basil, Thai Magic</i>	Seed from Johnny's Selected Seed. Annual. Thai basil is a great summer vegetable basil with a mild taste.
<i>Chives, Purly</i>	Seed from Johnny's Selected Seed. Perennial. Nice bite. Good with potatoes, veal marsala, and beef stew. Have some fun: make chive butter and sour cream!
<i>Cilantro/Coriander, Santo</i>	Seed from Johnny's Selected Seed. Annual. Leaves are typically used in salsa. The seeds are found in Middle Eastern, Central Asian, Mediterranean, Indian, South Asian, Mexican, Texan, Latin American, Chinese, African and Southeast Asian cuisines – now that's an all-around spice!
<i>Dill, Bouquet</i>	Seed from Johnny's Selected Seed. Perennial. Great fresh and for seed. Essential for pickling.
<i>Dill, Wiemken Heritage</i>	Seed from Beverly Wiemken of Polo, Illinois. Perennial. Great fresh and for seed. Goes great with salmon and potato/macaroni salads.
<i>Mint, Common</i>	Seed from Johnny's Selected Seed. Perennial. A zesty addition to salad mix. Variety not stated since mint does not grow true-to-type from seed.
<i>Oregano, Greek</i>	Seed from Johnny's Selected Seed. Perennial. Essential for Italian and Greek cooking.
<i>Rosemary, Common</i>	Seed from Johnny's Selected Seed. Tender Perennial. Pine-scented, ornamental evergreen. Essential for lamb and bean dishes. Best to grow in container; and spend winter inside house, basement or heated garage.
<i>Sage, Common</i>	Seed from Johnny's Selected Seed. Perennial. A staple herb used in dressings, sausage, sauces and tea. Also dries well for floral wreaths and swags.
<i>Savory, Summer</i>	Seed from Johnny's Selected Seed. Annual. Peppery flavor essential to beans, cabbage and sauerkraut. Also used in teas.
<i>Thyme, Summer</i>	Seed from Johnny's Selected Seed. Perennial. Essential in soup and stews. Retains flavor when dried.

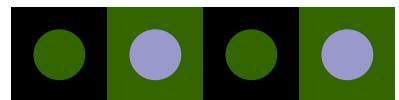
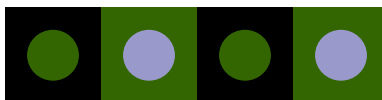
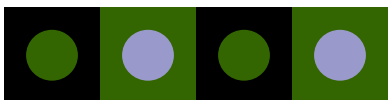

Tomatoes

<i>Dr. Wyche's Yellow</i>	Seed from Seed Saver Exchange. Indeterminate. Very large yellow-orange tomato, meaty and dense. One-pounders are very typical on productive plant. Long vines. The late Seed Saver Exchange member, Dr. John Wyche, was the owner of a circus who used elephant manure to fertilize his garden, and lion and tiger waste to keep away deer and rabbits.
<i>Green Grape</i>	Seed from Seed Saver Exchange. Indeterminate. Green-yellow grape tomato on very well-behaved, squat bushy plants. Spicy yet sweet 1" fruits. Consistently productive and the relatively compact shape of plant makes harvesting easy.
<i>Isis Candy</i>	Seed from Seed Saver Exchange. Indeterminate. From the mouth of babes: "Yum". Kids love this variety. Sweet, fruity cherry tomato that is marbled with red. Productive plant with 1 1/2" fruit that benefits from a trellis.
<i>Valley Girl</i>	Seed from Johnny's Selected Seed. Determinate. This hybrid sets fruit under heat or cold stress. Uniform ripening of firm, smooth and crack-resistant fruit that is of average size.



Peppers

<i>Bell, Orange</i>	Seed from Seed Saver Exchange. Large peppers that ripen to orange but good taste while green. Very thick flesh and sweet. Very productive.
<i>Bell, Chocolate Beauty</i>	Seed from Seed Saver Exchange. Large peppers that ripen early to a yummy chocolate purple color. Very productive, average taste at green. Makes great pepper jelly.
<i>Pimento, Lipstick</i>	Seed from Johnny's Selected Seed. Medium pepper that ripens to a bright red. Exceptionally sweet.
<i>Jalepeno, El Jefe</i>	Hybrid seed from Johnny's Selected Seed. Medium-heat jalapenos. Big plants.
<i>Hot, Bulgarian Carrot</i>	Seed from Seed Saver Exchange. Extremely productive tall plants, quite hot. Crunchy flesh. Makes great chutney, salsa and jelly.
<i>Hot, Candlelight</i>	Seed from Seed Saver Exchange. Tiny, intensely red hot peppers on bushy plants. Makes an excellent edible ornamental.
<i>Hot, Fish</i>	Seed from Seed Saver Exchange. Variegated peppers on light cream to green variegated leaves. Makes an excellent edible ornamental.
